**R E V I E W O F L A S T W E E K**

Last week was An almost perfect week as 7 of our 8 Qualified Teaser teams were successful. Although our highest rated category last week was Very Good, all 3 teams in that category came through as Minnesota, Indianapolis and Green Bay all were Teaser winners. Of our 5 Marginal teams 4 were successful in Teaser play with Atlanta, New England, New Orleans and Kansas City each succeeding and just Tampa Bay fell short.

This week's feature breaks down the historical success rate all teams have had in 6 point Teasers across various pointsread ranges. For this study we looked at all NFL regular season games played between 1982 and 2010, a total of 6,766 games. The overall results show 9,124 Teaser winners, 4,154 Teaser losers and 254 Teaser pushes. That works out to an overall Teaser success rate of 68.72% (ignoring pushes).

The following table shows the Teaser results and percentages in five pointsread ranges broken down by Home Favorite, Home Underdog, Road Favorite and Road Underdog. In addition, the results for Home Pick

'ems and Road Pick 'ems are given (under the 'FAV' category on the 'Pick em" line) as are percentages and total results. Note that the Total results do not include the Pick 'em games but only sum the five ranges for the Home Favorite and Road Favorite categories.

Not surprisingly the best overall category is Home Underdogs followed in order by Road Underdogs, Home Favorites and Road Favorites. Of special note is how Home Underdogs fare in the + 1 to + 3 category range (i.e. teased up to + 7 to + 9). The nearly 74 % success rate over more than 900 games is truly impressive

Just one game shows the potential for having 'Two Way Teaser' winners this week:

Minnesota at Chicago

A total of 7 teams qualify for play this week. A full 7 team round robin would produce a total of 21 Teasers. Eliminating the lone Marginal team and doing a 6 team round robin would result in a total of 15 Teasers. Alternatively, using the 2 Excellent teams with one another and then tying each of them to each of the 4 Very Good teams or the 5 Very Good/Marginal teams would yield a total of either 9 or 11 Teasers.
