REVIEW OF LAST WEEK

Teaser results improved nicely in Week 4 as 5 of the 6 teams qualified as Marginal or better were successful in Teaser play including each of our top 5 qualified teams. Both Excellent teams – Kansas City and Detroit – were successful in Teaser play as was our lone Very Good team, Buffalo. Of the 3 Marginal teams both Baltimore and Chicago were successful in Teaser play while only the Jets came up short.

In a few weeks we shall begin our discussion of a hedging technique that can help protect existing winnings while creating the possibility for a massive weekly win through the use of "middles."

We have published the NFL Teaser Newsletter since 1988 with great success across the board, although the performance breakdown of the various categories will show some variance from season to season. Between 1988 and 2019 we have recommended over 3,800 teams (Marginal or better) for use in two team 6 point Teasers. The overall success rate over all categories has been 70.0%. There is no way to determine

the overall profitability from our Teaser selections because of the many ways of playing Teasers according to various strategies and risk profiles. But given that rate of success most of our subscribers have reported very nice profits over the 32 seasons.

Here is a breakdown of the results by category of how recommended Teaser teams have performed from 1988 through 2019:

Using this chart in combination with the Pointspread Range Chart to be presented in next week's issue will enable the astute reader to fine tune our weekly selections and perhaps improve the overall success rate in playing Teasers. It will result in more selectivity and less activity but the results will be well worth the time.

2 games show the potential for being 'Two Way Teaser' winners this week:

L A Chargers at New Orleans (Monday)

A total of 11 teams this week qualify as Marginal or better. A full 11 team round robin would produce a very high total of 55 Teasers. Eliminating the 3 Marginal teams and doing an 8 team round robin of the 2 Excellent and 6 Very Good teams produces 28 total Teasers. Doing a Teaser with the 2 Excellent teams and tying each of those 2 teams into each of the 6 Very Good teams or into each of the combined 9 Very Good and Marginal teams would yield either 13 or 19 total Teasers.
