REVIEW OF LAST WEEK

After a disappointing opening week and a great bounce back in Week 2 the results were as good as they can be in Week 3 as all 8 of our teams that qualified as Marginal or better came through in 6 point 2 team Teasers. Our lone Excellent team, the L A Chargers, was a winner as were all 4 of our Very Good teams (Philadelphia, Buffalo, Miami and Carolina. The 3 Marginal teams also each came through as Kansas City, Houston and Seattle were successful as Teaser plays.

We use historical Teaser performances as the basis for making our weekly Teaser Selections. Over the years we have fine tuned the process to make this essentially a mechanical exercise but the selections are all based on the past 6 season of results broken down into various categories and situations. Each year we present an overview of how all tams have done overall in 6 point Teasers over the previous 6 seasons. Here is the data for the 32 NFL teams in 6 point Teasers from 2017 through 2022, a total of 98 regular season games per team (16 per season for 2016-20, 17 for 2021 and 2022). Percentages exclude Pushes.

Just 2 game shows the potential for being 'Two Way Teaser' winners this week:

A total of 9 teams qualify as Marginal or better this week with a nice 2-5-2 distribution. A full 9 team round robin would produce a total of 36 Teasers. The most 'conservative' play would be a single 2 Team Teaser using the 2 Excellent teams. A more moderate way of play might be a round robin of the 7 Excellent/Very Good (a total of 21 Teasers) or that single 2 team Teaser of Seattle/Chicago and tying each of those teams into each of the 5 Very Good teams (an additional 10 Teasers) for a total of 11 Teasers). Adding the tying in of Seattle and Chicago into the 3 Marginal teams would yield an extra 6 Teasers for a total of 17.
