REVIEW OF LAST WEEK

Last week was again perfect as all 8 teams that qualified as Marginal or better succeeded in Teaser play including the two Excellent teams, Kansas City and Dallas. Both Very Good teams - Seattle and Indianapolis - also succeeded in Teaser play. Finally, all 4 Marginal teams (Carolina, Pittsburgh, L A Chargers and Baltimore) were also Teaser winners.

Continuing with our hedging analysis we ended last week by mentioning the 'double win' that occurs when we hit both our Teaser and our hedge play. This is the result we hope for as a secondary benefit of doing the hedge. The primary purpose for many people is to lock in and protect already gotten profits or to limit already sustained losses. The hedge, however, gives us the chance for a 6 point or greater middle at a relatively modest cost.

Often the Monday night line moves towards the Favorite so our best situation occurs when the Monday night Favorite is part of our open Teasers. If we have Denver, a 9 1/2 point Favorite teased down to - 3 1/2 in a Teaser, there is a good chance the by game time Denver may have risen to - 10 or even - 10 ½, giving us

an extra half point or full point when we play the Underdog as our hedge play at + 9 $\frac{1}{2}$, + 10 or even + 10 $\frac{1}{2}$. We hit our middle when Denver win by 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 or 9 points and will Push or win both plays if Denver wins by 10 and we have played the Underdog at + 10 or + 10 $\frac{1}{2}$.

Historically roughly 68% of all NFL games result in two way Teaser winners – games in which both sides in the same game cover in a 6 point Teaser. Thus there is a two in three chance that our hedge play, in general, will be successful and we will hit our middle. We'll continue from this point next week.

A rather low total of just 6 teams qualify this week as Marginal or better with an even 2-2-2 distribution of the Excellent, Very Good and Marginal categories. A full 6 team round robin produces a total of 15 Teasers. Alternative ways of play are somewhat limited but would include a round robin of the 4 Excellent and Very Good (6 Teasers) and tying each of the 4 into each of the 2 Marginal (8 Teasers) for a total of 14 Teasers, differing from the full round robin by excluding the 1 Teaser involving both Marginal teams.
